

## I'm using Jamf Pro

### Step 1

#### Create a web clip on iOS/iPadOS in Jamf Pro for Wonde School Portal

Navigate to the [Wonde School Portal](#) and search for your school. This can be via your school name, postcode, or URN.




Select your school and you will be taken to your individual Wonde School Portal login page.

Copy the URL of the page. You will need this for the next steps for both Jamf Pro and Jamf School..

## Step 2

### Create a mobile device configuration profile

1. Navigate to Jamf Pro Instance
  - a. Navigate to your Jamf Pro Instance.
  - b. Select **Mobile Devices** > Select **Configuration Profiles** > Click **New**.
  - c. Search for the Web Clips Payload > Click **Configure**.
  - d. Fill in the required fields.
    - i. **Label** | This will be what the App Icon will be named on the device.
    - ii. **URL** | Paste your Wonde School Portal URL here.
    - iii. **(Optional)** | Upload an icon that will be displayed for the Wonde School Portal app. If no icon is uploaded a Safari icon will be used.

## Step 3

### Jamf Pro Bookmarks in macOS self-service for Wonde School Portal.

1. Navigate to Jamf Pro Instance.
2. Go to **Settings** > **Self Service** > **Bookmarks**.
3. Click **New**
  - a. Fill in the required fields:
    - i. **Display name** | This will be the name for the icon within Self Service.
    - ii. **Description** | (Optional).
    - iii. **URL** | Paste the URL for your Wonde School Portal here.
    - iv. **Display** | Select whether you would like the page to open in the Self Service browser or the Default Browser (recommended).
    - v. **Icon** | Upload an Icon to be used in Self Service.
4. Scope to devices and **Save**.



# I'm using Jamf School

## Jamf School iOS/iPadOS web clips

1. Navigate to your Jamf School Instance.
2. Go to **Profiles** > then **iOS**.
3. Select **Enrolment Type**.
4. Profile Name | **Wonde Portal**.
5. Time Filter | **No**.
6. Select **Web Clips** from the **Payloads** then **Configure**.
  - a. Fill in the required fields:
    - i. **Label** | This will be what the App Icon will be named on the device.
    - ii. **URL** | Paste the URL for your Wonde School Portal here.
    - iii. **Icon** | Upload an icon that will be displayed for the Wonde Portal app. If no icon is uploaded a Safari icon will be used.
    - iv. Select from the other options if required.
    - v. Click **Save**.
